Local Transportation

Public transportation in the Boston area is excellent and from the Mount Ida College campus students can take the college shuttle to the train (The "T") and buses. Some train lines to the suburbs have limited service at night and on weekends so students must check schedules carefully. One trip to Boston inbound costs \$3 – return costs \$1.25. One way bus cost is between \$0.90 and \$1.55 depending on destination. "Monthly Combo" passes are available for unlimited bus and subway travel for \$71 (covering about 17 round trips on bus and subway). Nearest bus stop is at the corner of Dedham and Carlson Ave. Nearest "T" stop is Newton Center (D branch of the Green line).

Smoking Policy

Smoking is not permitted in the ELS Center. Smoking is permitted outdoors.

Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is the Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval.

Rooms (standard option): **Double (2 person)**

Students live in double rooms in Brown Hall, a typical dormitory building with shared hallway bathrooms. Rooms include a bed, dresser, desk and chair for each resident and a telephone and microfridge unit for each room. Phone, cable and internet connections are available in each room. Students must provide their own equipment. Linens are also included. Students clean their own rooms during their stay.

Meals Included: **19 per week** (breakfast, lunch, dinner daily)

Age Minimum: **17+ years old**

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines are available in the same dormitory building for a small fee.

Security/Resident Assistant: There is one resident assistant for each floor or wing (1 RA per 40 students).

Check-In: **9:00 am to 9:00 pm (Sunday) check-in**
During standard check-in hours, students with confirmed reservations need to announce their arrival at the campus security checkpoint at the entrance to campus. They then go as directed to Shaw Hall. A Residence Assistant will provide a key to the dorm room and the linen. A damage deposit will be requested. Students arriving later than noted check in hours should plan to stay in a hotel unless other arrangements were confirmed.

Damage/Key Deposit: \$100 damage deposit

Checkout Time: 9:00 am – 12:00 noon (Saturday)

 **Homestays**

Rooms: **Single (1 person)**

Meals Included: **14 per week** (daily continental breakfast & dinner)

Age Minimum: **17+ years old**

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Families or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Most students use the train or bus to come to the campus.

Check-In: **8:00 am to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in**
Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 1:00 pm (Saturday)

Center Arrival Information
