### ✓ Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is the Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval. Please see "Check-in" instructions in the following sections for exact arrival details and times.

### Student Residence / Dorm Roger Williams University Maple Hall, Bristol, RI

#### Rooms (standard option): Doubles (2 person)

Shared typical on campus dorm rooms. Shared bathrooms (1 "male or female only" shared bathroom per 6 to 8 students within a pod). "Pods" contain a mix of male and female rooms. Rooms include a bed, wardrobe, desk, chair and dressing area.

Telephones are provided, along with cable and DSL access. Linens are also included. Students clean their own rooms during their stay.

Meals Included: **19 per week** (student's choice of meals)

Age Minimum: **16+ years old**

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines are available in the same dorm building for a small fee.

Security/Resident Assistant: Each student is provided with their own set of keys for their dorm rooms, and access to the building. Only students living in Maple Hall have keys that will allow them access to the residence hall. There are also "Call Boxes" located outside most entrances to the buildings on campus. These "Call Boxes" immediately connect the caller to the police. There is one resident assistant for each floor or wing (1 per approx. 40 students).

#### Check-In: 3:00 pm to 9:00 pm (Sunday) check-in

Students with confirmed reservations report directly to Public Safety for check-in assistance into the residence hall. Students arriving later than noted check-hours should plan to stay in a hotel unless other arrangements were confirmed.

Damage/Key Deposit: Each student must complete a credit card authorization form in order to cover any incurred expenses in the event of damage or lost key at the time of check-out.

Checkout Time: 11:00 am (Saturday)

### Homestays

Rooms: **Single (1 person)**

Meals Included: **16 per week** (daily continental breakfasts/dinners with lunches added on weekends)

Age Minimum: **14+ years old**

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Families or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Most students arrive at the campus by bus. Some families are close and provide bicycles.

Check-In: 12 noon to 9:00 pm (Sunday) check-in

Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 1:00 pm (Saturday)

### Center Arrival Information

New Students should report to the ELS Bristol Center at **8:30 am on the first Monday** of their program for registration, the ELS placement test and orientation. New students need to bring the following items:

- Passport (plus I-94 card & I-20 form, if applicable)
- Funds to pay tuition and housing and other relevant fees (or receipt showing pre-payment)
- Proof of medical insurance (or funds to purchase ELS insurance)
- Materials contained in the acceptance package
- All Students:* Completed & Signed Health Form & Immunization Record. These forms are included in the acceptance package.
