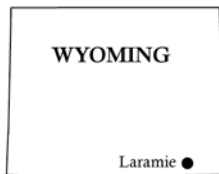

Local Transportation

There is no public transportation in Laramie. The University of Wyoming has a free shuttle bus within the university campus areas. Most campus locations and the Laramie downtown can be reached by foot.

Smoking Policy

Smoking is not permitted in the ELS Center or campus dormitory, but students may smoke outdoors.

Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is the Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval.

Males & Females live in separate “wings” but may be on the same floor. UW has a strict policy on having guests of the opposite sex in rooms after 10 pm. American students are in the same dorms but not in the same rooms as ELS students.

Rooms (standard option): Doubles (2 person)

Shared typical on campus dorm room. Shared hallway bathrooms. Rooms include 2 twin beds, 2 student desks, one sink, double wardrobe. Linens are also included.

Meals Included: 15 per week (student's choice of meals)

Age Minimum: 17+ years old

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines are available in the same dormitory building for a small fee.

Security/Resident Assistant: Doors are secured 24 hours per day. Each floor has 2 resident assistants.

Check-In: 12 noon to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in

During standard check-in hours, report the front desk of Downey Hall (ph: 766-2126), which is located on Grand Ave. Push the buzzer at the front door, and the desk assistant will open the door. The desk assistant provides room keys and assists with check in.

Damage/Key Deposit: None

Checkout Time: 1:00 pm (Saturday)

🏠 Homestays

Rooms: Single (1 person)

Meals Included: 16 per week (daily continental breakfasts/dinners with lunches added on weekends)

Age Minimum: 16+ years old

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Families or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Students are responsible for their own transportation to ELS. Many students either walk, or use bicycles and some families drive students to and from the campus.

Check-In: 12:00am to 9:00 pm (Sunday) check-in

Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 1:00 pm (Saturday)

➔ Airport Arrival Information

ELS recommends that students choose the ELS Airport Pickup Service for arrivals into Denver International Airport (booked through Central Admissions).

Area Airports: Laramie Airport (LAR) is closest to Denver International (DEN) may also be used.

ELS Airport Pickup Service Information:

Denver Int'l Airport - Airport pick-up service from Denver to Laramie, WY is available with at least 1 week's notice (with arrival details). The provider used for Denver to Laramie airport pickup service is: Capital City Cab (used only for arrivals into DEN)

The driver will hold a sign with the student's name on it. Airport Pickup Meeting Locations at Denver Int'l are:

International: Outside International Arrivals area in main terminal after leaving Customs)

Domestic: Outside Arrivals just as you come off the train to go to the baggage claim – if you miss the driver there, go to the baggage claim for your flight.

Laramie Airport – Students can call Capital City Cab upon arrival at this airport. Their local phone number is (307) 632-8294. It takes about 20 minutes for the cab to meet you at the airport after the call. Students will meet the cab driver in the arrival area before they turn and head to the baggage claim (\$20 anywhere in Laramie).

Other Transportation Options From the Airport:

Denver Int'l Airport – Students that arrive into Denver should consider pre-booking a connecting flight to Laramie Airport or pre-arranging an ELS airport pickup service from Denver (\$200 each way). Alternatively, a Shamrock Express shuttle may also be taken from Denver to Cheyenne, Wyoming (\$34). From Cheyenne, the student must take a taxi from Laramie for an additional (\$50 - \$125 plus tip).

Center Arrival Information
