### Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS student residence/dorm reservations should go directly to the Security office at FIT upon arrival. Students with homestay reservations will be taken to the host family address. Check-in is the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is the Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval.

Rooms (standard option): **Doubles (2 person)**

Shared typical on-campus dorm room. Shared hallway bathrooms. Rooms include a desk, a bed, a mini fridge, a small microwave, an end table and a chair. Linens are also included.

Meals Included: **19 per week** (to be determined by student – typical breakdown is breakfast, lunch, dinner M-F, brunch and dinner weekends)

Age Minimum: **18+ years old**

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines are available in a nearby dorm for a small fee.

Security/Resident Assistant: The Security office is located behind Shall Hall dormitory. There is one resident assistant for each floor or wing (1 per approx. 10 students).

Check-In: **24 hours (Sunday) check-in**

Upon arrival for check in all students (including males) should report to the Security office at Shaw Hall. Students then receive assistance with check-in to the relevant assigned residence hall.

Key Deposit: \$100 key deposit

Checkout Time: 9:30 am (Saturday)

 **Homestays**

Rooms: **Single (1 person)**

Meals Included: **14 per week** (daily continental breakfast & dinner)

Age Minimum: **14+ years old**

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Families or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host families drive ELS students to the campus in the morning and pick them up after class Monday thru Friday.

Check-In: **10:00 am to 11:00 pm (Sunday) check-in**  
 Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 12 noon (Saturday)

→ **Airport Arrival Information**

ELS Language Centers recommends that students choose the ELS Airport Pickup Service for arrivals to Orlando International (to be indicated on the application), other transportation options are up to the student to arrange.

Area Airport: Orlando International Airport – Center can arrange for transport (must be indicated on the application and flight information must be provided).

Melbourne Int'l Airport – Student must call a taxi for transport.

Other Transportation Options From the Airport:

Taxis from Orlando International airport are not recommended because are very expensive (over \$150 on average). ELS strongly recommends use of the ELS airport pickup service for arrivals into Orlando International airport.

Taxis from Melbourne International Airport to the FIT campus (to "Dorm Circle off of Country Club Road at Florida Institute of Technology") will cost approximately \$12 plus tip, with a travel time of 10 minutes. Therefore we do not offer airport pickup service from Melbourne Regional airport.

**Center Arrival Information**
