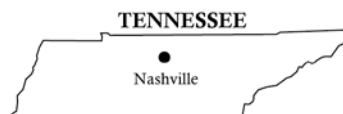

Local Transportation

Public transportation consists of buses, but they are limited in reach. MTSU does have a bus line near it, which will take students to downtown Nashville. Since Murfreesboro is not a large city, it will be reasonable for students to share taxis as well. Student housing offers shuttle services to campus and local shopping malls.

Smoking/Alcohol Policy

Smoking is not permitted in the buildings at MTSU or in the student residence. Designated smoking areas are found throughout campus. Alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, liquor) are strictly prohibited at MTSU. Student housing allows alcohol if residents are over 21 years of age.

Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval.

 **Student Residence**

Males and Females live in separate apartments.

Rooms: Single Occupancy

Students have private bedrooms with private bathrooms. Students share the living room, kitchen and laundry machines with two other students. Rooms include full-size bed, dresser, desk, chair, and closet. Linens are included and the kitchen is supplied with utensils for cooking and eating. Each room has Internet and Cable TV access. The living room includes a TV.

Meals Included: None - Can purchase meal card at the cash register of the MTSU cafeteria after arrival for any amount of money desired. The card may then be used any time the student wants to eat on campus.

Age Minimum: 18+ years old

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines are available inside each apartment. These are free.

Security/Resident Assistant: 24-hour emergency assistance available on site. There is one on-site American student resident assistant.

Check-In: 12:00 pm to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in

The Resident Assistant is available from 12 p.m. to 10 p.m. on "Check In" Sunday. Please go to 2707 S. Rutherford Blvd., Murfreesboro, TN 37130. The Resident Assistant will provide keys. If the Resident Assistant is unavailable, you may contact the Nashville Center Helpline (1-800-859-8871) for assistance or wait for the Residence Assistant as he may be helping another student to his/her room.

 **Homestay****Rooms: Single (1 person)**

Meals Included: 14 per week (daily continental breakfast & dinner)

Age Minimum: 16+ years old

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Families or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Some host families drive students to/from the campus and some require a commute by bus.

Check-In: 8:00 am to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in
Students go directly to homestay address.
