Local Transportation

Portland offers excellent public transportation such as the user-friendly Tri-Met bus and MAX light rail systems. The bus fare from campus to the downtown is approximately \$2.00 each way. The nearest bus stop is a 2 minute walk from ELS. The public transport within the 300-block downtown Portland area is free of cost. The city also has excellent bicycle paths.

Smoking Policy

Smoking is not permitted in the ELS Center or any building on the campus of Concordia University. Smoking may only take place at designated smoking stations around the campus.

Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is the Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval.

On Campus Student Residence/Dorm Concordia University in Portland

(various residence halls used - see check-in note)

Rooms (standard option): **Doubles (2 person) or Triples (3 person)**

Shared typical double (or triple) on campus dorm rooms. Shared hallway bathrooms. Rooms include a bed, closet, desk, chair, microwave, mini-refrigerator, telephone and internet access. Linens also included.

Meals Included: **Includes \$395 credit per session to use in the cafeteria**

Age Minimum: **17+ years old**

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines are available for a small fee.

Security/Resident Assistant: Public Safety is present on campus 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Each residence hall has a resident assistant to aid students.

Check-In: **10:00 am to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in**
During standard check-in hours, report to Elizabeth Hall located at 6400 29th Avenue. Outside of Elizabeth Hall, there is a phone on the wall. Students dial "8517" and tell security they are an ELS student. A security worker will then come and take the student to the residence hall for check-in.

Damage/Key Deposit: \$50 damage deposit

Checkout Time: Saturday at noon

Inn at the Convention Center 420 NE Holladay Street, Portland, OR 97232

The Inn at the Convention Center is the location of our off campus dormitory. Shared typical double hotel room. Shared private bathroom. Rooms include a bed, closet, desk, chair, microwave, mini-refrigerator, free use of fitness center, iron/ironing board, cable TV, telephone (with free local calls) and internet access. Linens are also included. Self-service machines are available for a small fee.

Rooms (standard option): **Doubles (2 person)**

Meals Included: **None** – students can prepare meals in room or purchase meals in local eateries.

Age Minimum: **18+ years old**

Homestays

Rooms: **Single (1 person)**

Meals Included: **14 per week** (daily continental breakfast & dinner)

Age Minimum: **14+ years old**

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Families or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Most students use the convenient Max-Train or bus system. In the downtown area, the ride is free.

Check-In: **8:00 am to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in**
Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 12 noon (Saturday)

Airport Pickup Meeting Locations are as follows:

International & Domestic: Baggage Claim (in front of the escalator) Baggage claim is located on the first floor of the International/Domestic terminal.

Other Transportation Options From the Airport:

From Portland Int'l Airport, students can take either a taxi or door-to-door shuttle to their destination. After exiting the baggage claim and crossing 2 roadways to get to the information booth. The information booth can give directions on the Max (light rail), door-to-door shuttle or taxi directly to the address desired. Travel time from the airport to campus or most homestays is about 30 minutes.

Center Arrival Information

New Students should report to the ELS Portland Center at **8:15 am on the first Monday** of their program for registration, the ELS placement test and orientation. New students need to bring the following items:

- Passport (plus I-94 card & I-20 form - if applicable)
- Funds to pay tuition and housing and other relevant fees (or receipt showing pre-payment)
- Proof of medical insurance (or funds to purchase)
- Materials contained in the acceptance package
- On Campus Dorm Students:* Completed & Signed Health Forms included in acceptance package.
