### Local Transportation

Teaneck offers convenient public transportation to New York City and surrounding areas. The #168 bus to New York City is in walking distance from the campus and costs approximately \$3.20 one way. The nearest train station (reachable by bus) is located in Hackensack and can take students to Hoboken where there are other trains to New York and other parts of New Jersey. Students also often take taxis together.

### Housing Check-in and Departure

Rooms (standard option): **Doubles (2 person)**

Shared campus dorm room. Shared suite-style bathrooms. Rooms include bed, desk, lamp, dresser and closet. Linens are also included. Students clean their own rooms during their stay.

Meals Included: **None**

Age Minimum: **18+ years old**

Laundry Facilities: Machines are available in Linden 8, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor. Free

Security/Resident Assistant: Building locked at all times. Front door is accessed with swipe card. Rooms are accessed with a key. There are 2 resident assistants: 1 male & 1 female.

Check-In: **10:00 am to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in**

During standard check-in hours, students must first report to the Office of Public Safety (at 870 River Road) where they will pick up their room assignments and linens. They will then be escorted to their rooms.

At registration on Monday, students can arrange for phone, internet access and ID cards. **IMPORTANT - Students will not be allowed to check-in until their FDU Health Forms have been completed and approved by the FDU Student Health Center A copy of the health forms should be sent to ELS Central Admissions or Teaneck at least 4 weeks prior to arrival. Please note: a meningitis vaccine is required and for some countries, this is only possible to obtain in the U.S. If this is your case, please contact the Teaneck center as quickly as possible.**

Flight Information: Home stay students should notify their Host Family Coordinator or ELS of their arrival times so that families will be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Students use a bus to come to school, which usually includes a transfer at the Hackensack bus terminal.

The driver will hold a sign that says "ELS Language Centers." To confirm that you have met the correct driver, your driver will show you an ID card from "GK Limousine & Travel". Be sure that this is presented. Airport Pickup Meeting Locations are as follows:  
 International: Your driver will be waiting for you as you exit customs. If you do not see your driver, walk to the closest public telephones and wait. Do not leave as your driver will meet you there.

Other Transportation Options From the Airport:

The nearest airport is Newark Liberty International (EWR). Taxis from EWR airport to campus or homestays will cost approximately \$60 plus a 15% tip, with a travel time of 25 to 30 minutes. Taxi service from John F. Kennedy Int'l and LaGuardia airports cost about \$85 plus tip and take over 1 hour to reach Teaneck. Students arriving late should plan on hotel accommodation until the next business day.
