Location: Beautiful suburban campus located in charming, historic Vicksburg. Jackson, the capital of Mississippi, is within a 1/2 hour drive.

Climate: Semi-tropical with four distinct seasons

Student Body: Co-educational, boarding grades 7 – 12; 122 boarding and day students, 24 international students

Average Class Size: 8 students

International Student/ESL Program: International students are required to take an ESL class in place of a regular English class. While studying grammar, pronunciation and written and oral expression students will learn more about the culture and history of the USA.

Athletics: Boys and Girls; basketball, soccer, softball (girls only), tennis, volleyball. In addition, the school has created a nationally recognized physical fitness program that is tailored to individual students and incorporates more than 50 different sports and enrichment activities. All students participate in the physical education and recreation program every year.

Campus Features: The beautiful 40 acre campus contains 3 girls' dorms, 2 boys' dorms and historic administrative building with dining hall and library, chapel, rectory which is home to the Head of School, skateboarding and tennis courts, gymnasium with rock-climbing wall, soccer fields, track, disc golf course, sand volleyball court, competition-size swimming pool, high and low ropes course, and student center.

Extracurricular Activities: Students engage in weekly community service activities. They also may sing in the choir, participate in creative writing workshops, and become involved in Student Council or the National Honor Society. Private music lessons are available. In addition visits to local museums, art galleries, historic sites or other venues of interest are regularly scheduled.

Marking System: All Saints' Episcopal School incorporates an Achievement/Trust System into all aspects of student life. Each week the School's administrators review each student's record and offer constructive feedback. This positive, pro-active system promotes self-discipline and self-accountability in each student. Grades are reported to parents quarterly.

Accreditations: All Saints' Episcopal School is fully accredited by the National Association of Episcopal Schools, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, and the Southern Association of Independent Schools.
