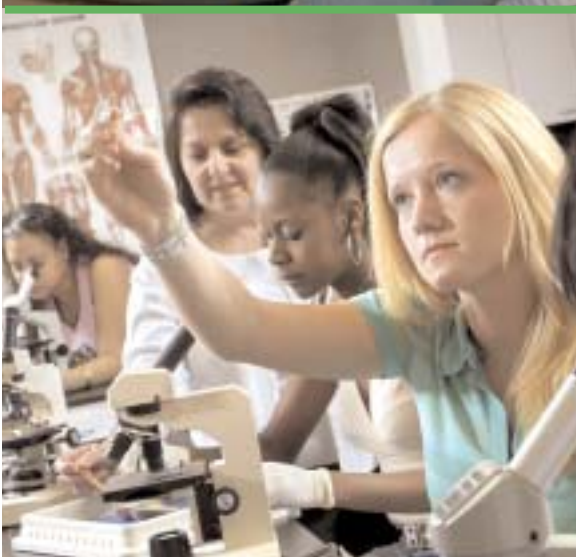

Campus Size: Twelve buildings on two facing city blocks

Location: Situated on charming Beacon Street in Boston's historic Back Bay, Fisher College offers students an educational environment that is truly rare: the intimacy and personal attention of a small institution and the excitement and opportunities only a city like Boston can provide. Students are housed in residences on Beacon Street – just around the corner from Boston Common – in one of the most exclusive and safest areas in Boston.

Athletics: The College has four varsity sports: men's basketball, baseball, women's basketball and softball. In addition to these teams, Fisher College also offers a health club membership and a variety of intramural opportunities.

Campus features: The *Academic Center for Enrichment* is staffed with professional tutors who assist students with all aspects of learning, including organizational and study skills. Tutors also are experienced with identifying student's academic difficulties and providing the appropriate tools for students to become skilled, independent learners. *First year advisors* are experienced faculty assigned to every incoming freshman to assist in the transition to college life. They help students grasp the importance of organization, time management, utilization of potential resources and personal responsibility as essential tools for academic success. *Transitional ESL Program* at the intermediate and advanced level permits students to acquire 6 academic credits (with the permission of the ESL instructor) while acquiring sufficient English proficiency for the regular academic program.

Success Rate: Fisher College students excel both in finding rewarding careers and in furthering their education. 98% of associate degree graduates find jobs upon graduation; 25% of students remain at Fisher to continue into a Bachelor Degree program. Another 40% transfer to four year programs at universities such as Babson College, Bentley College, Boston University, Emmanuel College, Northeastern University, Simmons College, University of Massachusetts – Amherst, University of Massachusetts – Boston, and Lesley University, among others.

Accreditation: Fisher College is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges.
