Articulation Agreements: Harcum students have been accepted at more than 200 four-year colleges and universities.

Location: Bryn Mawr, Pennsylvania, Mid-Atlantic region of the USA, 12 miles west of central Philadelphia (20 minutes on the train) in an area known as the Main Line, 6 college and universities within a 3 mile-radius of campus, and 2 hours from New York City and Washington, DC

English Language Academy: A member of the American Association of Intensive English Language programs. Students accepted at any level. Classes are 20 hrs./week. Advanced level students are encouraged to enroll in credit courses. ELA students may participate in all facets of the College. ELA offers small classes and professional instruction to students who want to improve their skills for academic preparation. An American cultural component includes field trips to museums, historic sites, special events, and on-campus seminars. Six enrollment dates throughout the year.

Center for International Programs: Designed to foster cultural adjustment of international students and encourage their academic success. Services provided include orientation, immigration advising, cultural activities and arrangement for short-term homestays during vacation periods.
