Location:	The Marywood campus is a beautiful national arboretum in a safe and charming residential neighborhood of Scranton (pop. 78,000) bordering the Pocono Mountains and within a two-hour drive of New York City and Philadelphia.

Athletics:	NCAA Division III; <i>Men's intercollegiate sports</i> include baseball, basketball, cross-country, lacrosse, soccer, swimming and tennis. <i>Women's intercollegiate sports</i> include basketball, cross country, field hockey, lacrosse, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis and volleyball. Marywood also offers club sports, fitness options, recreational classes, activity clubs and access to outstanding fitness and recreational facilities.
Campus Features:	<p>First year students are normally housed in a co-educational dormitory with key-card access, wireless study and TV lounges, air-conditioning, laundry facilities and a live-in resident director and assistants.</p> <p>Upper-class students have a choice of townhouse apartments or a residence hall featuring suite-style rooms, lounges on each floor, a large kitchen, and a 20 seat movie theatre.</p> <p>More than 80 clubs and organizations represent a wide variety of academic disciplines as well as athletic, arts, recreational, multicultural, political, social, religious and service oriented pursuits.</p> <p>Facilities include a Center for Performing Arts with a theatre, recital hall and teaching studios. The Center for Athletics and Wellness includes a fitness center, a rock-climbing wall, running track, swimming pool, racquetball courts, aerobic room, gymnasium and saunas. Outside athletic facilities include new multipurpose athletic fields, tennis courts, sand volleyball court, basketball courts, and soccer field.</p> <p>The Center for Natural Health and Sciences includes environment science facilities and a newly renovated biotechnology research laboratory.</p> <p>A new state-of-the art Center for Architectural Studies for the School of Architecture recently opened in 2009 and a Center for Healthy Families houses a human performance laboratory and nutrition laboratories.</p>
