### Program of Study

To graduate, students must successfully complete a minimum of 6 courses per semester and successfully complete a minimum of 20 academic credits including:

English . . . . . 4 credits  
Math . . . . . 3 credits  
Science . . . . . 3 credits  
(includes biology, chemistry or physics)  
History . . . . . 3 credits  
(includes US History)  
Foreign Language . . . . 3 credits  
Visual & Performing Arts . . . . . 1 1/2 credits  
(including at least 1/2 credit in each)  
Theology . . . . . 1 credit  
Life Skills & Public Speaking . . . . . 1/2 credit

*In addition, each student must fulfill the Physical Education/ Athletics and Community Service requirement.*

### Honors & AP Courses:

Upon student readiness, Advanced Placement exam preparation can be offered in 22 subject areas. Honors level courses are offered in each department.

### College Placement:

99% of graduating seniors enroll in universities such as: American University, Brown University, Brandeis University, Cornell University, Dartmouth College, Harvey Mudd College, Middlebury College, New York University, Rhode Island School of Design, University of Chicago, Vanderbilt University, among others.

- Location:** Situated on a lovely 78-acre campus in South Florida only five miles from the Atlantic Ocean.

- Student Body:** 584 students grades 9 – 12; 15% boarding. 12% of the students are international.
- Average Class Size:** 16 students; in some cases as few as 5
- Faculty:** 88 full-time faculty  
47 faculty and/or administrators live on campus

- ESL Program:** Saint Andrew's offers ESOL for students entering grades 9, 10 and 11. It offers Intermediate ESOL which is devoted to developing grammar and writing skills, and Advanced ESL which prepares international students for successful graduation from Saint Andrew's School and the rigors of a university curriculum.

- Campus Features:** Saint Andrew's School campus, with its 20 buildings in the airy Colonial Caribbean style, resembles the intimate educational environment of a small college. Within the last two years, 18 million USD have been invested in renovations and new buildings including a state-of-the-art science center, an athletic and aquatic complex and a center for the performing arts.
