Honors & AP Courses:

Upon student readiness, Advanced Placement exam preparation can be offered in Algebra I & II, American History, Biology, Calculus, Chemistry (Honors), English Literature & Composition, and World History.

Special Academic Programs:

Honors section, accelerated programs, independent study, study at local college for college credit, academic accommodation for the gifted, the musically talented, and the artistically talented.

College Placement:

99% of graduates go on to colleges or universities including institutions such as Duke University, Georgia Tech, Dartmouth College, Vanderbilt University, University of California, University of Georgia, and University of Virginia.

International Student / ESL Programs: Tallulah Falls School offers ESL I, II, and III. Students are mainstreamed into all other courses. The ESL teacher is always available after school for additional help and tutoring.

In addition, the school takes advantage of its magnificent setting to offer a multitude of activities including outdoor education, outdoor adventure, hiking/backpacking, rafting, rappelling, rock climbing, alpine skiing, snowboarding, strength & conditioning, among many others.

Campus Features: 22 buildings on more than 400 acres. Facilities include a new dining hall and student center, two computer labs, an industrial arts lab, media center, indoor swimming pool, gymnasium and a 300 seat auditorium. Boys and girls dorms were recently renovated.

Marking System: Each student meets with her/his advisor daily. Grades are reported to parents every nine weeks.
