American Bachelor Degree Programs

The University of New York in Prague (UNYP) is recognised as both a Czech and American-style institute of higher learning. The four year American educational model requires students to take introductory courses in many fields during their first two years. This gives students a basic understanding of many subjects, before they start concentrating on their major areas of study.

Another advantage of the American model is the classroom approach. Classroom discussions and assignments are designed specifically to develop the students' **critical thinking skills**, which are essential for **effective decision making and leadership**.

Other advantages include a focus on **group work** and **class presentations**. Group work teaches students how to handle varying group dynamics which is an important corporate concept. Presentations develop students' confidence and public speaking skills which are essential in effective leadership.

The structure of the program prepares students for **global employment**. Proficiency in conducting business in English and familiarity with the cultural aspects of working in an international environment are stressed. This is essential for students interested in career opportunities with either multi-national corporations or domestic companies with extensive international business activities.



Admissions Requirements

Admission to the program is set to ensure high standards are maintained. To be accepted onto the course, students will need the following minimum requirements

- Secondary school/high school diploma (maturita)
- Proof of English language ability (minimum TOEFL score of 530 written/197 electronic/71 internet). Other English language test results (such as IELTS, CAE, FCE, SAT, or ACT) may satisfy this requirement.
- Successfully conduct an entrance interview with a program representative



Our approach places a great deal of emphasis on **global aspects of commerce**, which is particularly critical in today's business environment. With our multi-national faculty and student body, UNYP is in a particularly strong position to provide this valuable international perspective.

Graduates have **a wide range of options as to where they pursue their careers**. Some graduates have gone on to study at universities such as Oxford or LSE in England, and Stanford or Columbia in America. Others are working for international companies such as General Motors, Coca-Cola, The European Parliament and KPMG. The program also serves as a strong grounding for those who wish to pursue careers in the public sector, civil society or academia.

Structure of the 4 year American Bachelor's Programs

At UNYP, students have the opportunity to earn internationally recognized American bachelors degrees. The American daily bachelors programs are offered in the following modes.

Dual-Degree Programs - An American Bachelor's Degree from State University of New York, Empire State College AND a Czech Bachelor's Degree from UNYP

Single-Degree Programs - American Bachelor's Degree from the State University of New York, Empire State College

- Majors:
- Psychology
 - English Language and Literature

The American degree that UNYP students receive is identical to the degrees that students in America receive on their graduation.

Transfer Credits

VOS graduates, holders of a British HND, an American Associate's Degree or any higher education institution course completion may be eligible for advanced standing.

Course Schedules

Classes are scheduled from Monday to Friday. There are three semesters, Spring, Fall and Summer. Most courses consists of 45 hours of contact time (lectures, seminars, tutorial meetings, etc). This includes a final time-constrained exam or project at the end of each course.

Instructors

Over 80 instructors from 13 different countries regularly teach at UNYP. The majority are native English speakers and are chosen for **both their academic and professional experience**.

Resources

UNYP's library is open 7 days a week, and has a study room and a computer lab where students can work on assignments. Three

other computer labs are available at the university. UNYP's library provides study materials for all courses. It is not necessary to purchase textbooks but students are encouraged to do so to have ready access to materials. UNYP students also have access to the ProQuest 5000 International set of online databases from the school's computer labs. An additional research database, Emerald Insight, is available via the Internet. An intranet system provides students with access to individual course material, course discussion boards, transcripts, and their financial status. WIFI is available within the university for students who register their equipment with our IT department.

Options for Further Study

Graduates may apply to postgraduate programs at universities in the Czech Republic and abroad. A progression to an MBA or MA program is quite common for students who have completed their Bachelor's degree. UNYP also offers international MBA and Master's programs that complement the Bachelor's program.

Recognition and Accreditation

These programmes are recognized and accredited by the Czech Ministry of Education, and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools (US). UNYP is also recognized by other official bodies, including the British Accreditation Council (BAC) and the Czech Association of MBA Schools (CAMBAS).
