School, Accommodation & Facilities - All Under One Roof

Clubclass Residential Language School is located in Swieqi - a quiet residential area only a stone's throw away from the hustle and bustle of St. Julians. School amenities include large, bright, air-conditioned classrooms, free Wi-Fi within the school, 24 hour Internet Café, Self Study Centre/Library and a Multipurpose Room. Residence facilities include an outdoor pool, fitness centre, indoor pool, sauna, jacuzzi, pub, restaurant, cafeteria and launderette.

A range of accommodation, all inspected and licensed by the Malta Tourism Authority, is available to ensure that every budget and requirement is catered for. Accommodation options include private or shared apartments (within the same building as the school), hostel and student houses (situated across the road from the school), host families (within walking distance of the school) and accommodation in hotels situated within close proximity of the school could also be arranged.

English & Photography

Clubclass Residential Language School has teamed up with Kevin Casha, one of Malta's best known photographers and photography lecturers, in order to offer an innovative combination of English language tuition, photography fundamentals and location workshops.

Programme Highlights

This programme is aimed at people who would like to improve their level of English and utilise their free time in Malta in order to achieve a better understanding of the fundamentals of photography both through formal tuition and through practical workshops in Malta's best photographic locations.

The General English Course offered during the mornings of the programme provides effective training for students who need English for work, study or travel. Experienced teachers use a course book and supplementary material to help students produce and practice the four language skills. The aim of this course is to help participants to communicate, and emphasis is placed on encouraging fluency and confidence in the English language.

During the photography sessions, Kevin will introduce the participants to the fundamentals of photography with the aim of achieving better camera handling and an overall improvement in the quality of pictures taken. This will be done through 4 lectures and 3 location workshops (2 half-days and 1 full-day).

The programme includes:

- 🕒 Photography course (4 lectures and 3 location workshops)

- 🕒 Airport transfers on arrival and departure

Kevin Casha is one of Malta's best known professional photographers and certainly the most decorated in terms of awards, accolades and publications both locally and internationally. He is a former President of the Malta Photographic Society and the current Chairman and founder of the Malta Institute of Professional Photography. Kevin is the only person to have been awarded Honorary Life Membership of both associations in recognition of the enormous contribution he has given to photography in Malta.

Apart from his work as a photographer, Kevin is also technical coordinator of the Malta National Picture Archive, an International Judge and Lecturer both in Malta and in foreign countries including England, Ireland and Kuwait. His photography has been widely published with no fewer than nine books fully illustrated with his images.

Gained the Fellowship of the Society for Wedding and Professional Photography (SWPP) of UK.

2008

Invited by the Ministry of Chinese Culture to participate in the Jinan Photography Biennial. Won best Classic Portrait award in the same biennial.

2009

Awarded the "International Fashion & Beauty Photographer of the Year" by the SWPP in UK.

2011

Won 2nd prize in the First China International Internet-based Photography Competition hosted by China Photographers Association (CPA), which had over 16,000 entries.

Awarded the Master of the Societies by the SWPP in the UK – their highest accolade for his valuable contribution to photography and achievements in the international arena of photography.
