1: Who is eligible to sit for GAU Scholarship Exam?

Associate/Bachelor Degree:

Applicants who are in their last year or already graduated from High School; currently studying Bachelor degree in a university and are willing to transfer to GAU to continue their studies

Master Degree:

Applicants who are about to graduate or have already graduated from a Bachelor degree.

NOTE:

Please note that we will require the prospective student's academic documents before issuing any type of provisional or acceptance letter from the university.

2: Scholarship percentages & tuition fees

The percentage of the Scholarship awarded to students will range from 50% to 100% on **GAU's tuition fees only**. Please note that the scholarship **will not** cover other fees, such as the dormitory fee and deposit, registration fee, application fee etc.

3: Application, Registration and Activity Fees

100% scholarship students:

Application fee	50 Euro
Registration fee	500 Euro (per academic year)
Activity fee	250 Euro (per semester)

75% - 50% scholarship students:

Application fee	50 Euro
Registration fee	250 Euro (per academic year)
Activity fee	125 Euro (per semester)

4: Scholarship Secure:

100% scholarship students:	800 Euro
75% - 50% scholarship students:	425 Euro
Deadline for payment:	4 th July, 2016
Outstanding balance:	After their documents have been evaluated, the admissions office will send Provisional Acceptance Letters asking for a non-refundable tuition deposit.

5: Withdrawal Policy:

If the student withdraws from the university before the end of the program, the student will be required to pay the balance of the discounted tuition fee.

6: English Proficiency

All students who will be registering at GAU will need to undergo English Exam (unless internationally recognized certificate of English competence with sufficient score is provided). The scholarship will be valid during the studies at the Foundation English Program, if such study is needed.
